Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

The ReturnAccount message (camt.004) is sent by TIPS to the interested TIPS Actor in the following business cases:

- Account Balance and Status Query response,
- CMB Limit and Status Query response,
- Query response error,
- Account Floor and Ceiling notifications,
- CMB Floor and Ceiling notifications.

The message content differs depending on the business case.

For the above-mentioned business case “*Account Floor and Ceiling notifications*” TIPS checks the floor and ceiling defined for each TIPS Dedicated Cash Account involved. When the amount of their cash balances falls below the defined minimum amount of liquidity or exceeds the defined maximum amount of liquidity, TIPS generates information for the TIPS Actor. The pushed outbound camt.004 ReturnAccount message generated by TIPS is not only used by the interested TIPS Actor as mere notification that either the account ceiling threshold or account floor threshold is exceeded, but it could also be used to initiate automated liquidity transfers via the liquidity management application of the TIPS Participant.

As currently these messages, when used as “*Account Floor and Ceiling notifications*”, do not have a balance code FLOR or CEIL included, the liquidity management application of the TIPS Participant is missing the information whether to initiate a funding or defunding liquidity transfer. Therefore, automated liquidity transfers in the liquidity management application of the TIPS Participant, based on the provided camt.004, are for the time being not possible.

T2 and T2S already provide this information in their account floor and ceiling notifications and allow participants to make use of automated liquidity transfers when floor and ceiling thresholds are breached. This should also be possible with the TIPS camt.004 as in particular the use of instant payments is expected to increase significantly by the entry into force of the Instant Payment Regulation (IPR).

Description of requested changes:

Change Request form

A new field in the account floor and ceiling notification has to be enabled to provide information on the floor or ceiling notification trigger (FLOR/CEIL).

Overview of the impact of the request on TIPS (L2 view)

Summary of functional, development, infrastructure, operational and security impacts

Summary of functional impact:

Floor and ceiling notification mechanism and related message need to be updated in order to convey both information about current balance of accounts and CMB and floor/ceiling thresholds. In order to do so, a new *Type* optional tag will be introduced within camt.004. In addition, cardinality of existing tags will be amended in order to embrace this updated functionality. Indeed, in Account Floor and Ceiling Notification Scenario, the already foreseen parent tag *Multilateral Balance* will be reported twice, in order to display both the balance of the account and the threshold for the notification. In the scenario of CMB Floor and Ceiling notification, this parent tag, instead, will be reported only once for the threshold information, since the balance amount is reported in other specific tag of the message.

For all other scenarios, the behavior of the message remains unchanged, meaning that the *Type* information will not be reported at all.

Summary of application development impact:

We are assuming no specific order for the information provided through multiple *RtrAcct/RptOrErr/AcctRpt/AcctOrErr/Acct/MulBal* sections.

The XSD rules do not mandate any specific order for them.

Impacts on "TIPS Core"

The following processing flows, that may emit camt.004 ceiling/floor notifications, have to be amended to produce the enhanced camt.004 content:

- Process incoming pacs.002 EUR messages and emit enhanced account/CMB Floor and Ceiling notifications (camt.004)
- Process incoming pacs.008 NPC messages and emit enhanced account/CMB Floor and Ceiling notifications (camt.004)
- Process incoming Inbound/IntraService LT requests via camt.050: emit enhanced account Floor and Ceiling notifications (camt.004)
- Process incoming Outbound LT response via camt.025: emit account Floor and Ceiling notifications (camt.004)
- Process incoming Inbound/Outbound Contingency LT requests via camt.050: emit account Floor and Ceiling notifications (camt.004)
- Process incoming positive Recalls (i.e. pacs.004): emit account Floor and Ceiling notifications (camt.004)
- Process incoming beneficiary/"CSM reply" (i.e. via pacs.002) cross-currency messages and emit enhanced account/CMB Floor and Ceiling notifications (camt.004)
